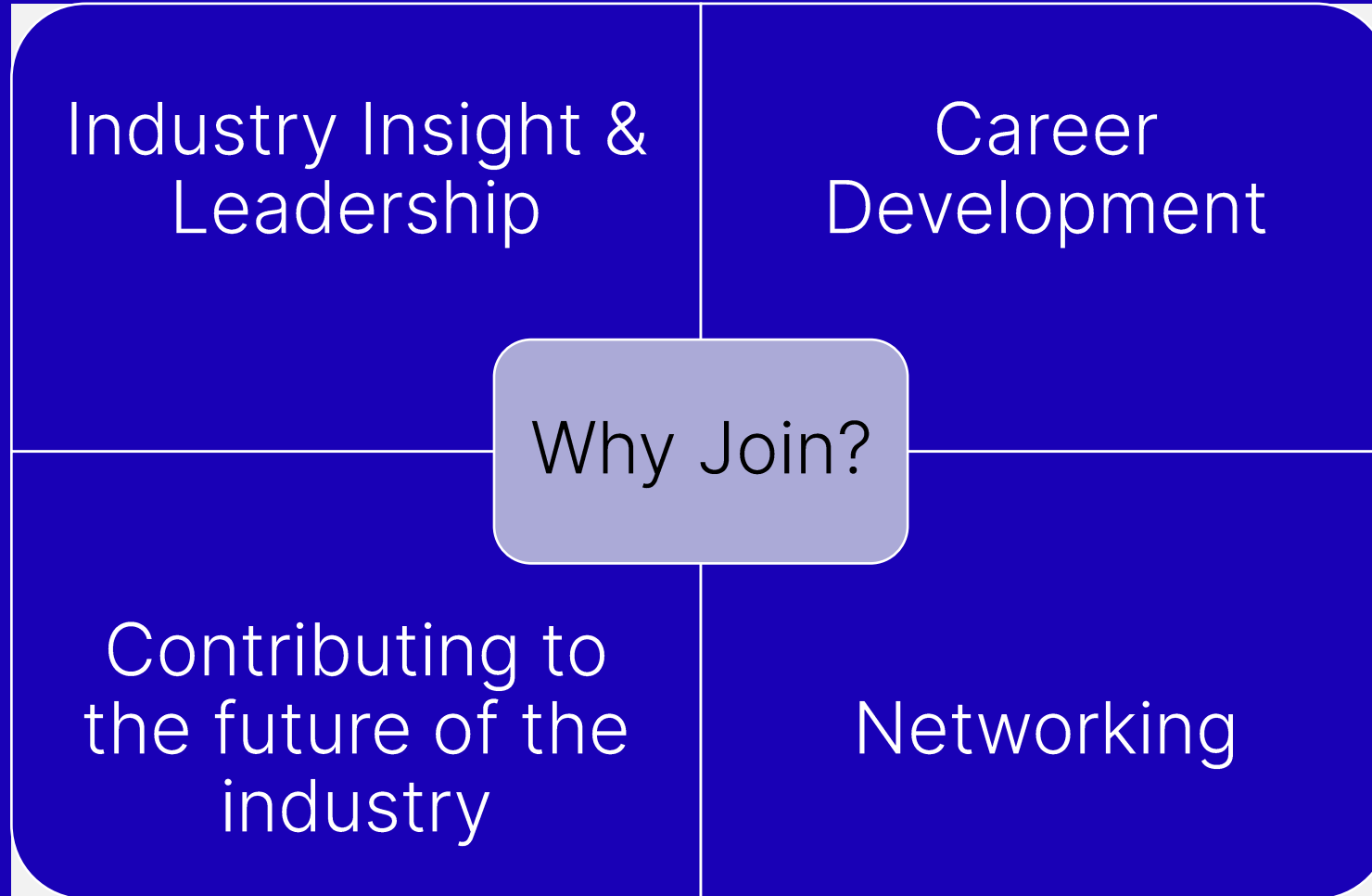

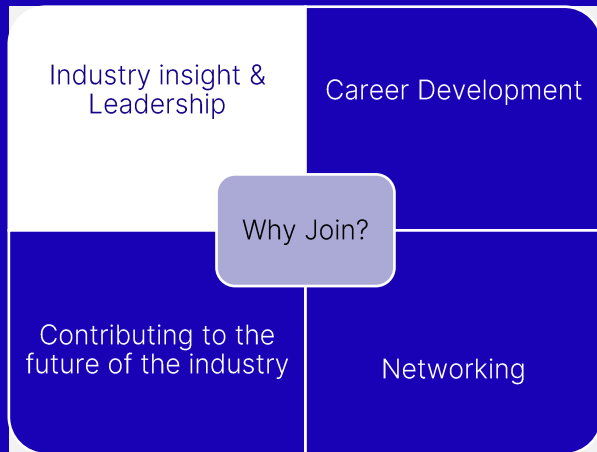
Common mis-conceptions

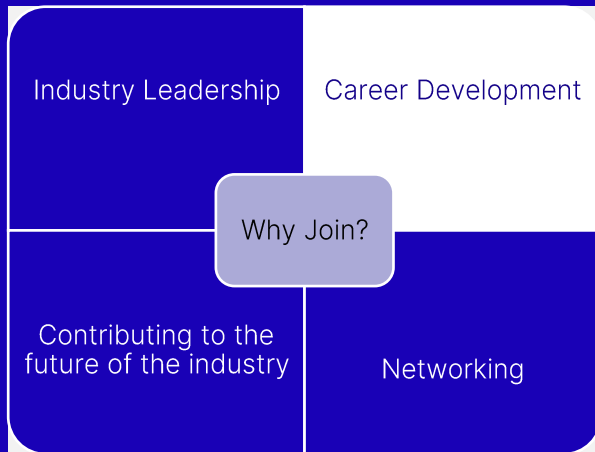

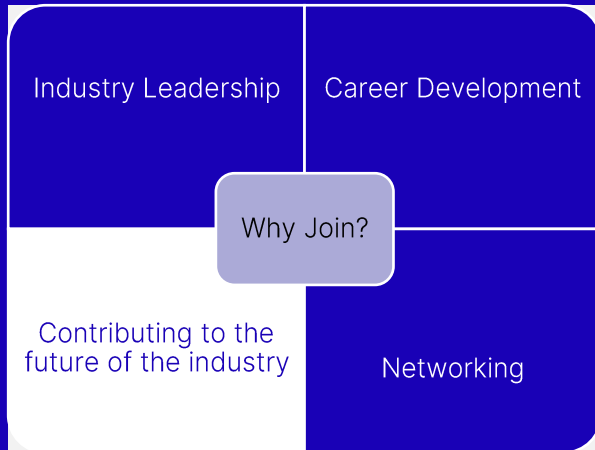

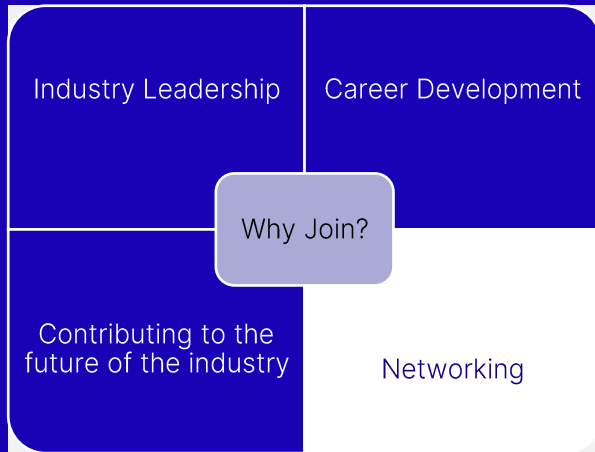

DEMYSTIFYING CONCURRENT DELAY

Host: Dr. Alan Whaley, Delay Expert, Arcadis

Delay-related disputes occur frequently in construction, yet practitioners continue to debate how concurrent delays should be analysed and allocated between parties. This is a particular problem in the Middle East, where traditional project-level thinking often clashes with the approach taken by leading tribunals.

In this session, Dr. Alan Whaley draws on leading case law and current practice to explore how experts and tribunals address concurrent delay in major disputes. He examines methods used to identify and quantify delays and concurrent delays and explains the different principles that apply in claims for extension of time and prolongation costs in cases of concurrent delay.
